**2. Approval of January 20, 2026, Meeting Minutes**

#### **4. Board Member Discussion**

- Dunn would like to see the Committee host public events to bring attention to the Village and the Committee. The Committee discussed a ‘start of summer’ gathering, held on the first Friday of June. Dunn will chair this event, with Jarman as the co-chair. Dunn will put together a proposal to be shared with the Committee before the next meeting. Laing will request use of the Bank parking lot of the event. Iacoangeli stated that there are funds available for a gathering of this style. Anna will chair the event and Mindi will co-chair. Anna will put together a proposal and get it out to the committee by the next meeting.
- Dunn suggested that the Committee consider having representation at the Village farmers market each Tuesday to create public awareness.
- Beia brought up the Village parking lot and the future potential of a group purchasing the former gas station for additional parking and potential use by the Village. Also discussed was the potential of branding the corridor similar to M22 in the future.
- Beia reported that she attended the housing coalition meeting and would share that information with the Committee.
- Laing reported that March would be the final meeting she would be able to attend due to a time conflict.

Motion by Dunn, seconded by Laing to move the meeting time from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM. moved to 6:00. Motion passed unanimously.
